EII PhD Fellowships

For Research Visits of 3-6 months

Objectives:

EII Fellowships provide opportunities for outstanding PhD students to undertake collaboration in a team of world-class researchers at a different university. EII Fellowships expand and strengthen research scope and experience, as well as broaden research contacts for PhD students.

Award Provisions:

- Return economy airfare within Australia if applicable
- Accommodation and subsistence allowance of AUD1600 per month for visits which require accommodation away from your usual residence.
- A subsistence-only allowance is available for visits within the same city or region where you still live at your usual residence.
- PhD Fellowship recipients will conduct their research under the guidance of a research host and research group

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be enrolled fulltime in the second, third or final year of PhD at an Australian university which is an EII member institution: <http://www.eii.edu.au/institutions>
- Students who have submitted their thesis, but not yet awarded the degree, are also welcome to apply.
- EII Fellowships cover research visits between EII member universities in Australia: <http://www.eii.edu.au/institutions>
- Requests for overseas visits will be considered on a case by case basis. The visit would have to be funded 100% from the EII funds available to the student's university or partially from the destination institution
- Applicants must be recognized by their advisor and school to have outstanding potential as a researcher

Conditions:

- To submit the application, students must first secure agreement from their Principal Advisor, their Head of School/Department, as well as the intended host university Advisor and research group
- Successful applicants must take appropriate action via their university if the receipt of the EII- PhD Fellowship conflicts with the conditions of other awards
- After the conclusion of the PhD Fellowship, the student will submit a summary of achievements and outcomes to EII

How to Apply:

Required Application Materials:

- Application form: Personal and research background
- Attachments: Research plan, and recommendation letters from Principal Advisor, Head of School/Department, and the Host University Research Advisor.

There is no deadline for applications. Applicants are welcome to apply at any time during the year.

- Decisions will be based on the applicant's overall potential for research excellence, their academic progress to date, and the degree to which their research interests align with those of the host research group.
