Items to Bring with You

- Extra items for warmth/comfort: Jumpers, coats, scarves, hot water bottles etc.
- Sensible clothing for all types of weather. The coast does get a lot of wind and rain at times. Make sure you have sensible footwear and spare socks.
- Toiletries
- Water bottle
- Mosquito and fly repellent
- Sunscreen
- It will still be winter and cold at Kioloa but if you're keen please bring your swimmers and a beach towel.
- Please bring your own writing/recording materials, including a hard folder, paper and pens. Please note that a hard folder is very important because there will not be any desks available.
- Delegates are expected to display their current research in poster form during the event. Please bring your research poster [A3 size or larger] with you to the School.

On Arrival & During your Stay

- We will greet you and provide you with a Kioloa Information Pack as well as keys for your accommodation.
- Read the water/swimming safety notices, displayed in the buildings.
- Under no circumstances, may you touch or use the fire extinguishers except in an emergency.
- Under no circumstances are fires allowed on the beach.
- Check with the Kioloa Managers first, before lighting an open-fire in the designated fire-pits. Total fire bans are sometimes in force, or weather conditions are unsuitable.
- Kioloa must dispose of its own garbage. Please ensure that you put your waste into the correct bins. If you're unsure, please ask.
- All food and tea/coffee/juice will be provided during the event. For personal purchases, there is a shop 5km from Kioloa. We will organize trips to the shop during the event.
- Wireless internet is available but you will need to bring your own lap top.
- All buildings are heated.
- Laundry facilities are available for a small charge.
