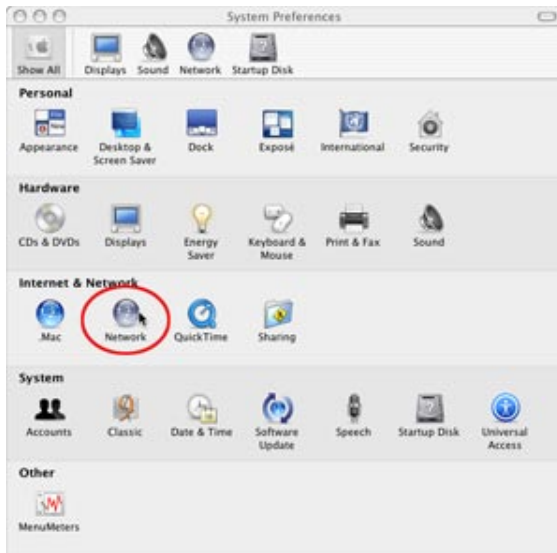


Setting up Your Mac OSX computer for Internet Access (DHCP)

1. Plug the data cable (Ethernet cable with RJ45 plug) into the appropriate port on your computer;
2. Power on your computer
3. Log in to your computer (if required)
4. Open "System Preferences" either from Dock or from Apple Menu

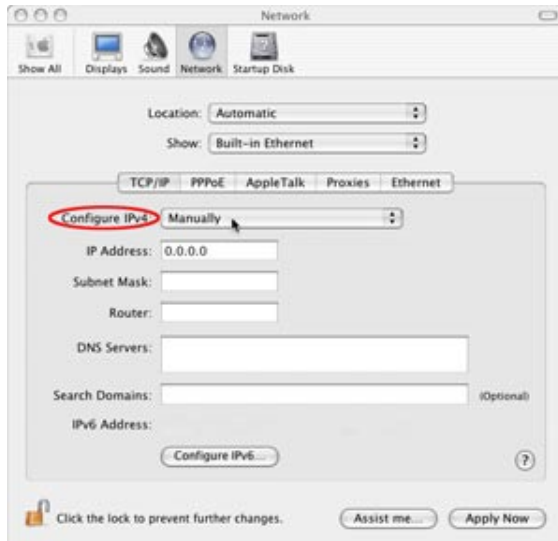


5. Click on "Network"



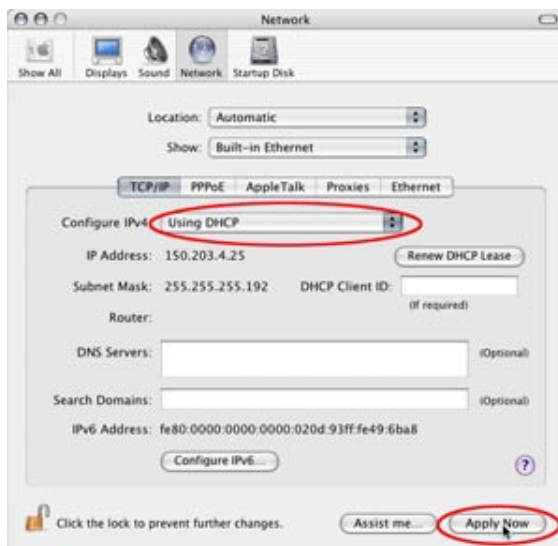
6. Highlight "Built-in Ethernet"

7. Click “Configure”



8. Take note of existing settings

9. Set “Configure Ipv4 to “Using DHCP”



10. Click “Apply Now”

11. Close “Systems Preferences”

12. Don't forget to reset your settings when you leave.
