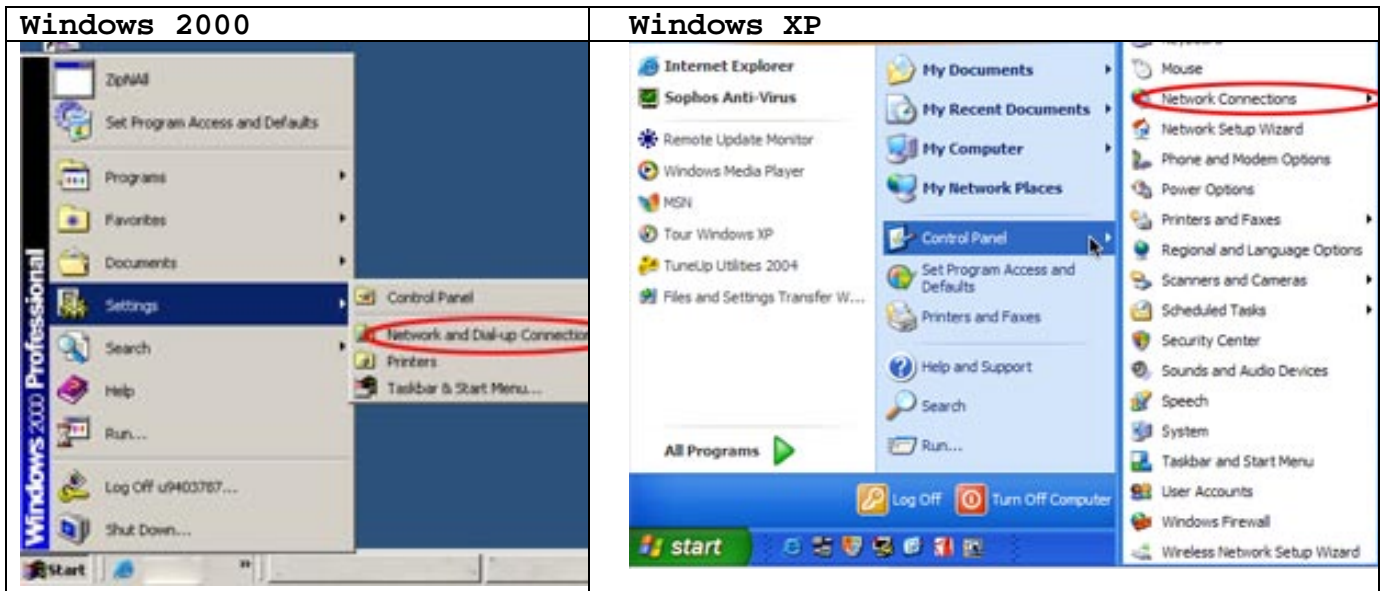


## Setting up Your Windows computer for Internet Connection

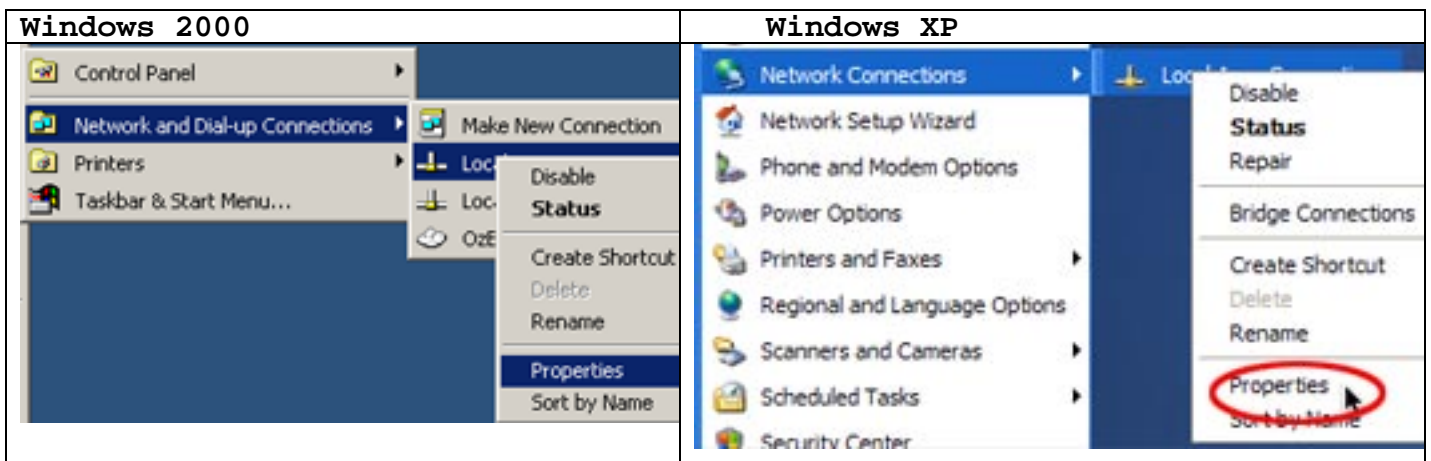
1. Plug the data cable (Ethernet cable with RJ45 plug) into the network port on your computer;
2. Power on your computer.
3. Click "Start" (at the bottom right hand corner of the screen)
4. Go to "Settings" (Win 2000) or "Control Panel" (Win XP)



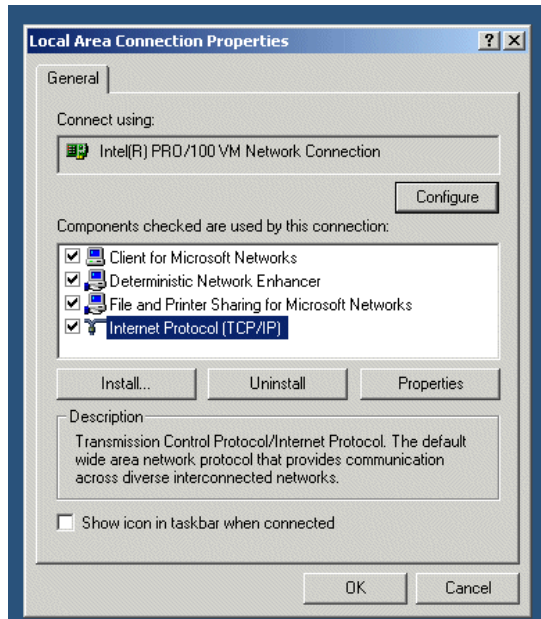
5. Click "Network and Dial-up Connections" (Win 2000) or "Network Connections" (Win XP)

6. Right-click "Local Area Connection"

7. Click on "Properties"



8. Select "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)"



9. Click "Properties" button

10. Take note of existing settings, to restore them when you leave.

11. Click "Obtain an IP address automatically" and "Obtain a DNS server automatically"



12. Click OK in both boxes.

13. Restart your computer.

14. Don't forget to reset you settings when you leave.
